Description: Contents include balance sheets, brochures, correspondence, minutes, and newspaper clippings. Baptist College Campaign Fund officially began on January 4, 1960. H. E. Ashby, "a prominent layman [and] a member [and treasurer] of Cooper River Baptist Church, [Charleston]" served as General Chairman. Dr. J. Roy Robinson, pastor of Citadel Square Baptist Church, Charleston and Chairman of the Baptist College Steering Committee served as General Co-Chairman. Dr. Chester F. Russell, pastor of Remount Road Baptist Church, North Charleston, and Secretary of the Baptist College Steering Committee served as Secretary and also chaired the Public Information Committee. File for 1960 includes list of Advisory Council Members as of December 15, 1959.

The Board of Founders first met on November 7, 1968. The following officers were elected: W.W.Walker of North Charleston, Chairman; Ben G. Teal of James Island, Vice Chairman, and J. Douglas Donohue representing The New and Courier and Charleston Evening Post., Secretary. A resolution made March 17, 1969 established the purpose of the Board as to "spearhead a campaign to provide Baptist College with a sustain goal of \$100,000 annually to assure the continuing financial solidarity and uninterrupted development of the college."
